



**Fit 'n Finish Presizing Instructions**

1) Make sure you printed this page full size (individual printer settings may vary) by checking the ruler to the right against a household ruler. If the measurements match, proceed to step 2.

2) Cut out the ruler to the right with a pair of household scissors.

NOTE: Trim very carefully, a sloppily cut ruler can lead to a poor wrist measurement.

3) Hold the top end of the ruler against the bottom of your wrist.

4) Wrap the ruler around the wrist as shown as tight as you would wear your watch.

5) The measurement closest to the arrow is your wrist measurement. Write this measurement down.

6) When ordering the watch through our website, enter the measurement listed that most closely matches your measurement.

7) Once you receive the watch in the mail, minor adjustments may be required to ensure a proper fit. These can be made by moving the spring bar in the clasp. If the watch is still too large or too small, a link may need to be added or removed by a trained specialist. The watch can be finely adjusted FREE OF CHARGE, by bringing both the watch and the "Fit 'n' Finish Certificate" to the nearest Dakota Watch Company retail location. If there are no locations near your home, the watch can be adjusted at any major jewelry store.

**PLEASE NOTE:**

The Fit 'n' Finish Pre-Sizing program does not guarantee that the watch will fit your wrist. It does guarantee a watch that has been pre-sized to the closest measurement received by the customer through our ordering process
